- $50 \%$ of Department requirements must be completed at UNLV
- Last 30 credits must be earned as a declared major in the College of Liberal Arts
- 2.0 Cumulative UNLV GPA required to graduate
- Maximum 4 credits of PEX can be used towards graduate requirements
- At least one Multicultural and one International course must be completed. Students can combine these courses with others in their major or the General Education.

HIST 212 - History of East Asia II
HIST 232 - History of Africa III
Or an additional Historical Survey course not already taken from the above options.

## Global or Multicultural

Choose one of these options:
HIST 103 - Global Problems in Historical Perspective
HIST 110 - History of Multiculturalism in America
HIST 260 - Intro to Native American History

## Historical Methods Requirements

These three courses must be taken in order:
HIST 251 - Intro to Historical Methods (complete at least one HIST course first)
HIST 351 - History Workshop (requires grade of C- or higher in HIST 251 first)
HIST 451 - Capstone Research Seminar (take in senior year; requires C- or higher in both HIST 251 and 351 and at least 9 credits of HIST coursework first)
