

It is possible to import several records from **Google Scholar** into UNLV Folio using BibTeX.*

▶ 1. Export your records from Google Scholar

- Log in to [Google Scholar](#).
- Select all of the relevant **citations** desired to export from the **My Library** screen.
- Click the **Export** icon.
- Choose the **BibTeX** format for the export.
- Copy the text **citations** that is displayed on the screen.

▶ 2. Import the BibTeX file into UNLV Folio

- Log in to UNLV Folio.
- On the **Activities** page, select **SCHOLARSHIP: Scholarly and Creative Work**.
- Click the **Add** button at the bottom of the summary table.
- In the **Import** box, choose **GENERIC (RIS / BibTeX)**.
- Click **Continue**.
- In the **Citation Format** drop down box, select **BibTeX**.
- Under **Citation Data**, choose **Copied Text**. Once you do this, a blank text box will appear.
- Paste the text you copied from the Google Scholar page into the textbox in UNLV Folio.
- Click **Save**.
- Review and select the citations you wish to upload.
- Click **Import Selected**.
