Notes

- Requirements for the certificate in Spanish Linguistics include 18 credit hours in the discipline.
- Must have an overall 2.0 GPA or higher in Spanish courses.
- At least 9 credits must be earned at UNLV.
- Any student placed above SPAN 213 will take additional Linguistics or supplemental courses to complete 18 credits of SPAN.
- Heritage speakers who grew up speaking Spanish may not take SPAN 213, SPAN 214, or SPAN 301. Instead, they take SPAN 226, SPAN 227, and SPAN 302. They take additional Linguistics elective or supplemental courses for a total of 18 credits of SPAN coursework.
