Pre-Major Entrance requirements: (1) choose Pre-Nursing on the UNLV undergraduate application for admission, OR (2) possess a cumulative 2.50 GPA or better while at UNLV to declare the Pre-Nursing major.

## **Minimum Requirements for Application:**

- 1. Completion of all prerequisite courses or enrollment of last remaining prerequisite courses listed on Pre-Nursing worksheet.
- 2. A minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA is required to apply to the Nursing program. If no UNLV GPA has been earned, the student's transfer admissions GPA will be used.
- 3. A minimum "B or higher" is required for MATH 124, BIOL 223, BIOL 224, BIOL 251, and NURS 299.
- **4.** A minimum "C or higher" is required for all other courses listed.
- 5. A review of your prerequisite courses must be completed by an academic advisor prior to confirm eligibility. Call (702) 895-5448 to schedule an appointment.

Note: Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee entrance into the School of Nursing BSN program.

## **Application Steps After Completion of Prerequisites:**

- 1. A formal application to the School of Nursing is required.
- 2. Students must apply one semester in advance of starting the BSN program. Applications are accepted in the following months:
  - -February for Summer admission
  - -June for Fall admission
  - -October for Spring admission
- 3. Complete a virtual BSN signing session to formally apply. Call the advising center main office (702) 895-5448 to schedule.
- **4.** Students are ranked on a point system by the Nursing Calculation Worksheet.
- 5. Students must have completed 50 or more credits of PRN prerequisites at UNLV to receive Rebel Recognition 1/2 point.
- 6. Up to 104 students are admitted into the BSN program every term based on students' total points earned on the Nursing Calculation Worksheet.
- 7. These 104 students will be accepted into School of Nursing BSN program which will begin the following semester.
- 8. Once admitted into the BSN program, students will be considered Nursing majors and the designation will change from PRN to NURS.
- 9. Nursing students will complete additional 60 additional credits of the full major BSN program (16 months).
- 10. After completing the BSN program, students will complete the National Council Licensure Exam-RN (NCLEX-RN).
- 11. Passing the NCLEX-RN is required to practice nursing in the United States.



NOTE: Substitutes for PSY 101 are EPY 303 & HON 201. Third social science must come from a separate discipline other than PSY & SOC. Substitutes for STATS are ECON 261, PSY 210, STAT 152, or STAT 391.

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\*In the healthcare profession, fingerprinting will be required.
